Our live-in carers provide you with **round-the-clock, one-to-one support** in the comfort and familiarity of your own home.


Our carers will live with you 24 hours a day to ensure you receive all of the personal support you need.

Frank's story

Frank is still determined to squeeze every possible drop of fun out of life and we love helping him to do it!

Frank is 85, is single and has dementia.

His two sons had always promised to help him stay in his own home for as long as possible. However, with both of them running their own businesses, they were unable to care for him themselves.

Frank has led an incredibly full and active life and still has an active mind and bags of energy. He speaks several languages, having served as a translator in the war.

He's represented Great Britain in table tennis and has played internationally – he even met his former wife whilst competing against her in Holland. He's also cycled all his life and has a passion for rugby and Spitfire planes.

As well as providing care and domestic help, we made sure Frank was able to continue to cycle. We fitted a tracker to his bike so he could safely cycle alone, with his carer keeping a careful eye from home. As his dementia progressed, his carers started riding with him.

Knowing Frank enjoys mental stimulation too, we also helped reignite some lifelong passions. One of his carer's can speak French and Frank loves the opportunity to put his language skills to the test.

Our carers often take him to watch Leicester Tigers with his sons or attend local air shows. We also signed him up to his local U3A (University of the 3rd Age), and he now plays table tennis every Wednesday morning. Before we began supporting him, he hadn't played for over 40 years.

Although Frank's dementia is progressive our care plan is reviewed regularly and adapted to his needs and abilities. This ensures that Frank is safe and well cared for whilst allowing him to enjoy a fun and active lifestyle.

Our Quality Standards

We are Regulated by the Care Quality Commission (CQC) and regularly inspected by them to ensure that the service that we provide is of the highest standard. In our latest inspection the CQC rated us as 'Good' across all areas. If you'd like a copy of their report we'll be happy to send one out.



Our process



1

Initial Enquiry

Pick up the phone or drop us a line! We'd love to learn more about you and explain what we can do for you.

2

First Meeting

We will come to your home and meet with you and your family so we can understand precisely the support you need.

3

Care Plan

We will prepare an individual care plan for you. This is a detailed document all about you, the support you'd like to receive and the care that we will put in place.

4

Recruitment

Once we've got to know you we will recruit carers with the right mix of skills, experience and personality. We obtain references and an Enhanced DBS certificate for all of our staff.

5

Second Meeting

We will introduce your carers to you and your family so you can get to know one another before the service begins.

6

Commencement

Our care services will start whenever you're ready and at a time to suit you.



All in all, this process takes around four weeks. It's not a quick solution but a sustainable one. It's a detailed process that ensures we get things off on the right foot.

Your circumstances will inevitably change over time but our promise to you won't: we'll look after you at home and help you enjoy the best quality of life you can.

Funding options



We're proud to offer extremely high-quality care at a price that represents excellent value for money. We understand however, that the cost of care is something that most people have concerns about.

Whilst care funding can be a daunting, and sometimes complex subject, there are options available. Please do give us a call so that we can discuss your particular circumstances to see how we can help.

■ Private Funding

Many of our clients fund their care privately. If this is you then we'd recommend speaking to a financial advisor who can help plan how to meet the costs over time. It's worth knowing that even privately funded clients are entitled to certain state benefits to help with the costs.

■ Local Authority Funding

Everyone is entitled to a Care Needs Assessment. If the assessment determines that you require care then the Local Authority will assess your finances to see if you qualify for funding. If you are entitled to financial support you can use that funding towards the cost of the care we provide to you.

■ NHS Continuing Healthcare Funding

If you have a disability or complex medical needs, typically requiring nursing care, you may be eligible for NHS Continuing Healthcare funding. Unlike Local Authority funding, eligibility is based purely on medical need and isn't means tested. We can assist with any applications for funding so please do contact us to find out more.
